I.1. Call to Order

1.2. The meeting was called to order at 2:45pm, presided by the Chairman, Gilbert C. Vilela, MD.

1.3. Dr. Vilela acknowledged the presence of the BAC Members, TWGs and the End-user/s. Proceeded to the Pre-Procurement inquiry and clarifications.

Other Matters:

1. Review of the Approved Budget for the Contract, re: Pest Control Services – c/o GSD (March-December 2020).

Mr. Alan Fruelda reported, current contract for Pest Control is P112,739.00 per month. Approved budget per APP is 1M for CY2020 (one year) – If based on this approved APP, its only P833.00/month only wherein there is a huge difference and the budget is not enough. Mr. Fruelda also informed BAC that he had already discussed this with Mr. Gerald Rabe of the Budget Division whom instructed him that there will be a budget adjustment on February, 2020 so to cover the difference. He further said that a communication was already sent to the Budget Division requesting for adjustment of the cost.

Ms. Cortez also updated BAC that there was one prospective bidder who bought bidding documents (D'3 Pest Management) despite its very low cost. As per Dr. Vilela, once Budget Division had adjusted the APP, will submit bid bulletin.

Dr. Vilela and Flores has commented on the result of this adjustment which will surely cause delays aside from this, Mr. Rabe had transferred to the Accounting Division, Archt. Caringal requested to fast-track the adjustment since the contract shall commence on March, 2020. Also to request Budget Division to expedite the adjustment to qualify for the opening of bids on February 12, 2020.

- 2. FYI copy of the Annual Procurement Plan for CY 2020 submitted by the Budget Division. Reviewed by Dr. Vilela and Dr. Flores, said that the approved APP for CY2020 is just an FYI.
- 3. TWG Determination of Lowest Calculated Bid of the Project, re: Conversion of Former Renal and Metabolic Division into CSS. TWG is working on it c/o Ms. Daisy Algenio and Ms. Elvira Torres.
- 4. Ayana Construction requesting for an extension of submission of eligibility of requirements for CSSR. Approved by Dr. Vilela, and may submit during the opening of bids.

Medical Supplies Computation – TWG validated the APP and was found out that there is a
discrepancy in the costing with the OR. Therefore, to request Operating Room to recompute their
costing indicating an underpriced PPMP.
