According to Ms. Elvira Torres, Chairman of the Technical Working Group, she found out that the total cost of the items have surpassed the allotted ABC ₱174,562,580.48 thus, there is a difference of ₱ 72,242,210.06. Mr. Lagon has to discuss the result with Ms. Torres. Both agreed that they still have to again review the abstract of sealed bid and the option is to remove non-essential items from the list so to fit to the ABC.

- 1. Status of the Early Procurement Activity (EPA) for 2023 (Short of Award for 2023).
 - End-users are expected to submit PRs by August, 2022 and bidding activity to start as early as November, 2022.
- 2. BAC Resolutions, re: CABG/Universal Packs Delivered to the OR last CY2019.
 - Items were already delivered and used in the OR in CY2019, however endorsement for BAC Resolutions were not done for unknown reason. Just recently, OR forwarded the request for BAC Resolutions to the Procurement Division and forwarded to the BAC Office.
 - BAC Secretariat call the attention of the BAC-A members on this matter by providing them the scenario that the documentation supposedly should have been finished the same year it was procured and used.
 - Since these items were used in CY2019, and BAC Resolution will be signed by the incumbent BAC members, so a concern was raised as per its validity and legalities.
- It was agreed to consult the matter to Atty. Manalang before acting on it. A meeting is set on July 20, 2022.
- 3. Cancellation of notice of Award Metro Drug, Inc. (MDI) will no longer be distributing the BD's products starting July 1, 2022, TNC Everlight Philippines, Inc. will be the appointed distributor of BD's products in the Philippines.
