## III. Other Matters:

1. Reschedule of the requested Actual Demonstration by the End-users relative to the Project, re: 1 Unit Tissue Embedding Center.

> JVA not applicable

> PASSED

- Communication from the End-user, Dr. Arlene De Luna requesting a reschedule of the product demonstration and signified intent to do site visit instead.
- The installation of Guill-Bern Corporation for the Project is in Dagupan City, Pangasinan. With reference to implementation of travel bans and its requirement, BAC opted to suggest to the Endusers to conduct actual product demonstration at PHC and for supplier to bring in their DEMO UNIT.
- Ms. Elvira Torres and Mr. Jaypee Caringal were called via telephone call to relay their insights on the request of an on-site visit. Ms. Torres stated that Dr. De Luna insisted so to ensure the performance of the Unit.
- Ms. Velasco instructed BAC Secretariat to communicate with Dr, Luna regarding the suggestion and to consider the 2 non-compliance of Guill-Bern Corporation to the Technical Specifications.
- Likewise, for the BAC Secretariat to communicate with the Supplier, Guill-Bern Corporation to conduct actual demonstration at PHC and bring in their DEMO UNIT.
- 2. Communication of Robustan, Inc. pertaining to the Project, re: 1 Unit Treadmill Stress Test Machine.
  - Robustan, Inc. as per principal supplier, they have discontinued the production of AAA alkaline batteries.
  - Ms. Velasco and Mr. Marcial Magleo reviewed the Technical Specification and allow Mr. Magleo to give details on what transpired during the Product Demonstrations.
  - Mr. Magleo noted that Robustan, Inc. used a lithium-ion battery during the demonstration. This
    was likewise noted by the End-users, who were also present during the activity. It was clearly
    stated by the End-users that they prefer to use the AA alkaline or AAA alkaline batteries.
  - However, for the purpose of demonstration it was lithium-ion battery that was used.
  - Notice of Award was issued to Robustan, Inc. n August 26, 2021.
  - Contract was put on hold. Majority of the BAC members and TWGs agreed that this is already considered as NON-COMPLIANCE to the Technical Specifications.

- BAC Secretariat was instructed to prepare communication to Robustan, Inc. to inform them of the End-user's feedback.
- 3. Letter of Global Medical Solutions , Inc. relative to the Project, re: 1 Unit Dual Head SPECT Gamma Camera System (c/o TWG).
  - This is noted by the BAC, TWG thru Mr. Magleo informed the body that the letter was a response to the End-user's request.
